Player Transfer Policy (Outdoor)

All transfer of players between the clubs in different seasons must adhere to the player transfer policy defined by Luxembourg Cricket Federation (LCF) as follows.

1. A player can only play competitive cricket for one club during the outdoor season of that year.
2. The official transfer period is fixed between 1st November to 1st December of every calendar year. There are no transfers outside of the prescribed transfer period.
3. The player must inform the club captain of his/ her old club of his/ her intention to move to a new club by email with communicationatlcfc@gmail.com and the new club's captain in cc.
4. A **club** is only entitled to receive 3 new club players per calendar year through the player transfer window. This is to prevent over-concentration of players in a few clubs. If a club receives more than 3 requests during the transfer window, the receiving club will decide which players they would like to register for their club.
5. Any newcomer to Luxembourg can join any club and are not subject to the restriction under point 4. However, they should not change clubs during the transfer period following their arrival in Luxembourg, only from the second transfer period onwards¹.
6. From the 2022 transfer window onwards, a player who transfers to a new club cannot change to another club for minimum of two years².
8. By exception, registered players for certain development clubs (University of Luxembourg CC and Luxembourg Under19s) are considered as 'protected' with respect to this transfer policy. U19 players must always remain with the U19 squad until they leave that age group. No more than 2 players may leave the University team in any transfer window. In case of more than 2 transfer requests from ULCC for a specific transfer window, then transfers are made first come first serve basis
9. It is recalled that clubs should not actively approach players registered with other clubs to encourage them to change club, whether with incentives or not, as this constitutes unwelcome "poaching" activity. The LCF Committee underlines that players themselves should make any first approach and will take appropriate action if a club should not respect this principle.

Note: A club with two teams should submit two exclusive squad lists by end of March each year and swapping between the squads is NOT allowed during the remainder of the LCF outdoor season of that year.
